RGB Spectrum QuadView HDx – For churches needing a simple way to control a complex video system, RGB spectrum is a company with a lot to offer. It began as a defense contractor and took the knowledge learned into the worship market. The QuadView HDx is a compact multi-viewer, a single screen with many discreet flowing images. It can display up to four images at once from source material ranging from DVI to RGB and do so with excellent de-interlacing and scaling. For lower resolution material, the HDxv version brings S-video and composite capability onboard plus it handles sixteen inputs in combination and then cycled through at regular intervals for informational displays. In the sanctuary, the HDx delivers instant resizing of images onscreen and simple movement to emphasize a point or move the next section. Much of the technology at play on CNN is accessible here and the learning curve is a wonderfully gentle slope, meaning literally anyone in the church with an affinity for video can operate it with confidence.

Movie Outline 3.1 – Storyboarding a worship clip and then bringing it to life are time-consuming tasks. It is estimated each minute of screen time requires four hours of work, so a seemingly simple five-minute pre-sermon piece takes half a work week to produce. Movie Outline 3.1 incorporate step-outlining, or sequencing, into a script formatting program. The essential element is to provide a way to build story and character while maintaining cohesion within the larger context. With integrated color-coding, a familiar pull-down menu system and industry-standard formatting, MO 3.1 is an excellent path to nurture budding screen writers without overwhelming them with the complexity of film writing or narrowing their creativity with a lesser program. It is compatible with Final Draft, the prevalent pro software and can import and export PDFs files as well. Dialog Spotlight helps maintain speech patterns and reduces repetition of words.

Though it may be slightly overwrought for most sermon series intro clips, it offers a method for those wanting to express themselves through video who may be lacking in the dialog department.

Native Instruments Alicia's Keys – If art imitates life, Alicia Keys is appropriately named. The Her personal keyboard is a cherished Yamaha C3 Neo grand and this package honors its exquisite tone with details recordings of the piano played by Alicia in her private studio. The results are practically identical sounds to those found on her albums but made useable in any worship setting. Backed by a stellar team headed by Alicia's personal engineer Ann Mincieli, the samples are based on a dozen velocity layers per key coupled to convolution algorithms designed to capture the sympathetic resonance among the Neo's strings. All this recording technology is combined with damper pedal engage and release data along with microphone and mechanical noises to create an authentic experience.
