Whatever else our worship is, it is essentially a response to God's endless self-giving. Alan P. Ross wrote that worship "refers to the appropriate response to the revelation of the holy God of glory." While we most often think of worship as something that man alone initiates, the perspective of Scripture is clearly that God has placed man in an atmosphere of constant worship, constant response to Himself as the Creator, an entire galaxy of worship that evermore responds to Him in praise.

"The heavens declare the glory of God, the skies proclaim the work of His hands," says Psalm 19, and man can do no less – we are literally geared from the Manufacturer to give forth His praises by our very existence on the planet, whether we understand it or not. Even those who despise, reject, or deny God cannot help but show forth His glory as human beings.
