Guitar Strumming Patterns

For the Rhythm Guitar Player

*Re-Cap - Explanation:

1. Learning to develop pulse and timing - individually and to the group
2. To creatively inspire new variations to freshen up your old/current songs

Purpose and Importance of the Rhythm Guitar Player:

1. Timing of strums to establish a solid pulse
2. Focus patterns to unify with the drummer (hi-hat and/or snare)
3. Project clarity in parts in sync with the other instruments
4. Practice with a click or metronome to develop the "inner clock"

Basic Guide for Patterns:

1. Play all strumming rhythms muted in one chord to get down the skeletal pattern.
2. Play all strumming rhythms open strings in one chord to establish comfortability.
3. Begin playing by using slower tempos to get the rhythms accurate.
4. Play as written - varying the combo between muted and open rhythms.
5. Gradually increase tempo to the song's original bpm.

Dennis Jernigan
Song Receiving and Leading Worship To The Broken

Interview Conducted By Branon Dempsey and Derek Williams

Author of the worship tunes "All In All" and "Who Can Satisfy My Soul," Dennis will share his powerful testimony and the authenticity of leading worship to the broken. You will not want to miss this conversation with Dennis as well as his downloadable music as a gift from Dennis. Links are here in the Show Notes.

You may not recognize the name or the face of Dennis Jernigan, but there is a good chance you know some of his music. Songs like "We Will Worship the Lamb of Glory", "Thank You", "Great is the Lord Almighty", "Who Can Satisfy My Soul (There is a Fountain)", "I Belong to Jesus", "Nobody Fills My Heart Like Jesus", and "You Are My All in All" have been sung widely by the body of Christ since the early 1990s.

Having written hundreds of songs (even though Jernigan does not see himself as a song writer but, rather, a song "receiver"), there is so much more to the man than simply a musician.

Dennis has given a great deal of his life to setting the spiritually captive free. Having walked out of a homosexual identity and into that of a new creation, he is convinced that with God NOTHING is impossible. Through the sharing of his story and the sharing of the stories behind the songs, Dennis Jernigan has watched literally thousands walk out of all manner of spiritual bondage and has watched literally thousands of desperate, wounded people find healing through intimacy with Jesus Christ.

If you lead people to freedom, they WILL worship.

Dennis Jernigan has been married to Melinda for 25 years. Together they have nine children (and no, they are not Mormon or Catholic and the children are not adopted... and yes, they know what causes that...and yes, they like it!). The Jernigans decided a long time ago that Dennis's first priority was that of husband and father so he never truly toured and they chose not to live in Nashville...not that there's anything wrong with any of that! This was simply the Jernigan's mandate from the Lord as they saw it. Perhaps that's why you do not know who he is. And that's just fine with him.

The life message of Dennis Jernigan can be summed up in one word. Freedom. That freedom has come with a price. Jernigan was born again through his faith in Jesus Christ...but the reality is that the battle for freedom from the lies of the enemy regarding his past identity has been ongoing. His greatest joy has come in seeking intimacy with Jesus Christ – and in the process, discovering greater depths of freedom than he ever realized. And he wants everyone else to know about the possibility of freedom in their own lives. Every song, every blog, every video, and every book he has written are all interlaced with the theme and hope and possibility of freedom. And so it is with his latest recording, "Kingdom Come".

"Kingdom Come" is a collection of 15 songs of freedom from Jernigan's perspective. The underlying theme of his heart is evident. Jernigan says, "If you lead people to freedom, they WILL worship."

5. When life hurts and a shattering has occurred in a person's life, in Christ, how is one to understand and work through the healing process?

Who can we as WL's lead the broken to that place of honest confession?
